### Morning Snack and Lunch:

On excursion days children tend to eat more so we recommend providing a little extra on these days. We are not able to heat or cook food provided for children's morning tea or lunch, please pack food accordingly.



We are **nut-free** in Vacation Care. We ask that you please do not send nuts or food which contains nuts to help protect those with allergies who use our service.

## Electronic Devices and valuable items:



We encourage you to have your child leave phones and smart-watches with internet capabilities at home. Should you have to contact your child while they are at OSHC please ring the service. Any child seen using these devices will have them confiscated and locked away for safekeeping.

We recommend children do not bring valuable items, including trading cards, to Vacation Care. However, if they do, educators are able to lock them away for safe keeping and monitored use. Please discuss this option at drop off to ensure educators are aware of any items which need safeguarding.

## Lost Property:



We do our best to make sure children put their belongings in their bags but ask that you help us by re-enforcing this with your child. We advise regular checks of the lost property during Vacation Care.

If possible please label clothes and belongings with your child's name or your family name so we can more easily assist in returning them.



## Hot Weather:

Please send your child with **sun block already applied** and in appropriate clothing for sun protection. We require all children to have a **wide brim hat and a drink bottle** with them each day of attendance. Please note that if these requirements are not met your child will not be able to take part in outdoor activities or excursions.

Educators will encourage all children to drink plenty of water and to re-apply sunblock throughout the day.

## Pocket Money:



Pocket money is only allowed on specific days and is optional. These are noted on the program with a gold coin symbol. Please hand money to educators at drop off time. Do not leave money with your child or in their bag. Pocket money should not exceed \$20 however we recommend around \$5 for a small treat. Pocket money is not to be given in place of a packed lunch.
